#### 4. Chair Report – Caitlin

- a. FO has undergone some changes over the last year including:
  - i. staff changes, from 6 employees to 3. This is largely due to the decrease in financial resources.
  - ii. Enhancing the governance model and increasing the number of Board Members

#### 5. Executive Director Annual Report

#### **Financials**

- a. Downsized structure from 6 active employees to 3.
- b. In 2019 there was some government funding challenges
  - i. funding was provided later than expected which created much uncertainty in the summer
  - ii. 2019 marked the end of the 3 year Trillium funded Grow Freestyle project
- c. FO must identify ways to be less reliant on government funding

#### Policy

- a. Creation of a Policy Committee. The mandate of the committee is to perform annual reviews of all policies to ensure they are kept up to date
- Reworked or created 4 policies: 1) Concussion Policy and Code of Conduct 2) Anti-Harassment Policy 3) Person in Authority Policy (Safe Sport) and 4) Coaches Code of Conduct

#### **Coach Training**

a. 14 coach courses during the 2018/2019 season, slightly down from the previous year

#### Ramp 2019

a. There have been more FO run programs launched with the Ramp, however, need to continue to get more users

#### **Events**

- a. During 2018/2019 season Freestyle Ontario hosted 10 sapling sessions, 9 Timber Tour events (141 individual competitions vs. 128 individual competitions in 2018)
- b. FO launched new official training course and new scoring software (that can could do live scoring) with 39 Judges and Officials trained and 5 scorers trained

### Women/Girls

- a. There is currently a large gender gap Freestyle Ontario objective is to improve female registration
- b. Female membership is up from 85 to 142
- c. Overall athlete membership is up with the female registration increasing at a higher rate

#### Membership

a. Membership is up 26% from last season, and 46% from the 2016-17 season.

#### **High Performance**

- a. High Performance Management Plan key objectives is to advance Ontario's athletes to the national team program, and for athletes to achieve high rankings at national and international competitions.
- b. All short term, long term, and overarching goals of the High Performance Management Plan are being achieved.

#### 6. Financials - Josh

- a. F2018 audit complete
- b. Need to focus on identifying new sources of revenue to be less reliant on government funding
- c. FO is in a much healthier cash position than in the past
- d. Expectations for 2019 FO should be in a similar situation in 2019. Revenue will be further decreased due to a decrease in team fees.
