RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Freestyle Ontario in partnership with Beaver Valley Ski Club.
- 2. Rules are based on Freestyle Ontario's Timber Tour Rules and Procedures.
- 3. Provincial Championships is comprised of four (4) events.
- 4. All athletes must have a Freestyle Canada certified Coach present with sufficient qualifications for their intended manoeuvres. The Head Coach of each Timber Tour team has completed training in all Comp-Intro courses, and must be coaching at the event. The list of required Comp-Intro training courses is available at https://freestyleontario.ski/coaches. Clubs who do not meet this requirement are encouraged to work with a club who is willing to share their Comp-Intro Trained coach and to work with Freestyle Ontario on a strategy to meet this requirement in the following year.
- 5. Qualifications are required for all inverted manoeuvres.
- 6. The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

SCHEDULE OVERVIEW

Sat. February 24, 2024 Slopestyle & Single Moguls Competition

Sun. February 25, 2024 Big Air & Dual Moguls Competition

Early Bird Registration Deadline: February 11th, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. EST.

<u>Entry Fees:</u> \$240.00 for two (2) events + 5% SnowReg fee. Participants must register online and make payment at the time of registration. Priority is given to athletes who register first if an event is full.

<u>Late Fees and Final Deadline:</u> There will be a 25% late fee on all Provincial Championship registrations completed two Sunday's prior to the event, and a firm registration deadline the Sunday before the event. Registration closes on February 18th, 2024 at 11:59PM.

AGE CATEGORIES: Age categories are determined based on the competitor's age as of January 1, 2024. **U10 ATHLETES REQUIRE FO APPROVAL TO REGISTER.**

- U12 10-11
- U14 12-13
- U16 14-15
- U18 16-17
- 18+

<u>REFUND POLICY:</u> At any point if a participant provides a doctor's note stating they are unable to attend the event after registering, a full refund will be provided minus the 5% SnowReg fee. A full refund will be provided, minus the 5% SnowReg fee prior to the Early Bird Registration Deadline for any reason.

Once the Early Bird Registration Deadline has passed, and a refund is required for a non-medical reason, only 50% of the fee will be refunded. If the event is cancelled due to Covid-19 or a related issue, FO will work to reasonably, to recoup losses where possible, and refund any revenue generated consistent with our practices and policies. There is no guarantee of a refund of any amount in the event of a COVID-19 related cancellation.

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, no refunds will be issued to that participant for the duration of the competition. If an event is cancelled due to weather on the day of the event, no refund will be provided.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

<u>SLOPESTYLE FORMAT</u>- Best of two runs, no finals. The number of heats is an estimate depending on the number of athletes registered for the competition. Participants can only train in the timeslot directly before their heat. Heats will have a maximum of 25 athletes.

Heat 1: Men 18+/U18, Women (All)

Heat 2: Men U16 Heat 3: Men U14 Heat 4: Men U12

<u>BIG-AIR FORMAT –</u> Either best of two (2) run format, *or* best of three (3) run format pending athlete field size. Jury will advise after registration has closed.

SINGLE MOGULS FORMAT – Best of two runs no finals.

<u>DUAL MOGULS FORMAT</u> - Modified seeded double elimination format. Skiers will be seeded based on the Ontario Mogul Rankings with the last ranked event being the event held on the last Sunday prior to the dual moguls event. All skiers have an opportunity to win their way into the Championship Bracket.

VENUE INFORMATION

<u>COMPETITION OFFICE</u> - The competition office is located in the Keg Tent inside of the Alpine Center at Beaver Valley Ski Club.

<u>LIFT TICKETS</u> – Competition lift tickets can be purchased for \$165.00 + tax for a three-day lift ticket at the registration desk. No refunds will be issued for individual days for any reason.

**Note: Lift tickets are not included in the price of registration. Athlete's skiing without a valid lift ticket will be disqualified from the event.
