RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Freestyle Ontario in partnership with Freestyle Calabogie.
- 2. Rules are based on Freestyle Ontario's Timber Tour Rules and Procedures.
- 3. The Competition is comprised of two (2) events.
- 4. All athletes must have a Freestyle Canada certified Coach present with sufficient qualifications for their intended manoeuvres. The Head Coach of each Timber Tour team has completed training in all Comp-Intro courses, and must be coaching at the event. The list of required Comp-Intro training courses is available at https://freestyleontario.ski/coaches. Clubs who do not meet this requirement are encouraged to work with a club who is willing to share their Comp-Intro Trained coach and to work with Freestyle Ontario on a strategy to meet this requirement in the following year.
- 5. Qualifications are required for all inverted manoeuvres.
- 6. The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

Early Bird Registration Deadline: January 14th, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. EST.

<u>Entry Fees:</u> \$120.00 for one (1) event + 5% SnowReg fee. Participants are encouraged to register for both events. Participants must register online and make payment at the time of registration. Priority is given to athletes who register first if an event is full.

Late Fees and Final Deadline: There will be a 25% late fee on all Timber Tour registrations completed two Sunday's prior to the event, and a firm registration deadline the Sunday before the event. Registration closes on January 21st, 2024 at 11:59PM.

















AGE CATEGORIES: Age categories are determined based on the competitor's age as of January 1, 2024. **U10 ATHLETES REQUIRE FO APPROVAL TO REGISTER.**

- U12 10-11
- U14 12-13
- U16 14-15
- U18 16-17
- 18+

<u>REFUND POLICY</u>: At any point if a participant provides a doctor's note stating they are unable to attend the event after registering, a full refund will be provided minus the 5% SnowReg fee. A full refund will be provided, minus the 5% SnowReg fee prior to the Early Bird Registration Deadline for any reason.

Once the Early Bird Registration Deadline has passed, and a refund is required for a non-medical reason, only 50% of the fee will be refunded. If the event is cancelled due to Covid-19 or a related issue, FO will work to reasonably, to recoup losses where possible, and refund any revenue generated consistent with our practices and policies. There is no guarantee of a refund of any amount in the event of a COVID-19 related cancellation.

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, no refunds will be issued to that participant for the duration of the competition. If an event is cancelled due to weather on the day of the event, no refund will be provided.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

SINGLE MOGUL COMPETITION FORMAT- Best of two runs, no finals. Refer to the schedule when released for a detailed overview.

<u>COMPETITION OFFICE</u> – Details on its location will be provided closer to the event. Access to this office will be limited.

LIFT TICKETS – Lift tickets will be available for purchase at a day rate of \$55.00 + HST (Lift ticket \$42.00 + \$5.00 RFID media fee + \$8.00 Lane access fee) and will be sold at registration.

We recommend using E-transfer as the primary payment method, directed to (<u>cpfctreas@gmail.com</u>). Kindly ensure to include the name of your athlete(s) in the note section of the E-transfer. Additionally, we will have the option to purchase lift tickets on the day of the event through Square, which accepts all major credit cards.

- Fee Breakdown
- RFID Media Fee a one-time fee to get the RFID weekend pass printed. Only payable on the first training day, day rate drops to \$50.00 + HST for event days.
- Lane Access Fee Used to help offset a portion of the cost to build / maintain the course by Freestyle Calabogie.

2 Day Pass - \$118.65 incl. tax (For athletes who are competing in one event)

3 Day Pass - \$175.15 incl. tax (For athletes who are competing in both events)

******Note: Coach passes are not complimentary.

<u>FO MEMBERSHIP</u>: Athletes must have a Provincial Athlete Membership to participate in the event. This membership provides all involved parties with liability insurance through FC.
