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## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Freestyle Ontario in partnership with Mount St. Louis Moonstone.
2. Rules are based on Freestyle Ontario's [Timber Tour Rules and Procedures](#).
3. The Competition is comprised of two (2) events.
4. All athletes must have a Freestyle Canada certified Coach present with sufficient qualifications for their intended manoeuvres. The Head Coach of each Timber Tour team has completed training in all Comp-Intro courses, and must be coaching at the event. The list of required Comp-Intro training courses is available at <https://freestyleontario.ski/coaches>. Clubs who do not meet this requirement are encouraged to work with a club who is willing to share their Comp-Intro Trained coach and to work with Freestyle Ontario on a strategy to meet this requirement in the following year.
5. Qualifications are required for all inverted manoeuvres.
6. The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

## SCHEDULE OVERVIEW

Early Bird Registration Deadline: January 21st, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. EST.

Entry Fees: \$120.00 for one (1) event + 5% SnowReg fee. Participants are encouraged to register for both events. Participants must register online and make payment at the time of registration. Priority is given to athletes who register first if an event is full.

Late Fees and Final Deadline: There will be a 25% late fee on all Timber Tour registrations completed two Sunday's prior to the event, and a firm registration deadline the Sunday before the event. Registration closes on January 28th, 2024 at 11:59PM.



**AGE CATEGORIES:** Age categories are determined based on the competitor's age as of January 1, 2024. **U10 ATHLETES REQUIRE FO APPROVAL TO REGISTER.**

- **U12 10-11**
- **U14 12-13**
- **U16 14-15**
- **U18 16-17**
- **18+**

**REFUND POLICY:** At any point if a participant provides a doctor's note stating they are unable to attend the event after registering, a full refund will be provided minus the 5% SnowReg fee. A full refund will be provided, minus the 5% SnowReg fee prior to the Early Bird Registration Deadline for any reason.

Once the Early Bird Registration Deadline has passed, and a refund is required for a non-medical reason, only 50% of the fee will be refunded. If the event is cancelled due to Covid-19 or a related issue, FO will work to reasonably, to recoup losses where possible, and refund any revenue generated consistent with our practices and policies. There is no guarantee of a refund of any amount in the event of a COVID-19 related cancellation.

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, no refunds will be issued to that participant for the duration of the competition. If an event is cancelled due to weather on the day of the event, no refund will be provided.

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## COMPETITION INFORMATION

SLOPESTYLE FORMAT- Best of two runs, no finals. The number of heats is an estimate depending on the number of athletes registered for the competition. Participants can only train in the timeslot directly before their heat. Heats will have a maximum of 25 athletes.

Heat 1: Men 18+/U18, Women (All)

Heat 2: Men U16

Heat 3: Men U14

Heat 4: Men U12

COMPETITION OFFICE – Details on its location will be provided closer to the event.

LIFT TICKETS – Competition Lift tickets are offered at \$70.00 + Tax per day. Athletes must purchase tickets ahead of time by creating an account on Mount St. Louis Webstore using the link here (<https://shop.mountstlouis.com/>). Please note, that in order to get the competition rate, the account must be made using the same athletes first name, last name, and DOB that is tied to their membership with Freestyle Ontario. Please see pass option below.

- **2 Day Lift Ticket** – For athletes only competing in one (1) weekend slopestyle competition (Official training and one event)
  - o \$140 + tax
- **3 Day Lift Ticket** – For athletes competing in both (2) slopestyle competitions (Official Training and both events)
  - o \$210 + tax
- **4 Day Lift Ticket** – For teams wanting to train on the Thursday (February 1<sup>st</sup>) before the event and compete in both slopestyle competitions. Thursday's unofficial training lift ticket will be valid from 9am-9pm.
  - o \$280 + tax
- **Coaches Lift Pass** – Coaches are entitled to complimentary lift passes, with a limit of two per club. To secure your pass, please send an email to [luke@freestyleontario.ski](mailto:luke@freestyleontario.ski) including your first name, last name, and date of birth before the registration deadline on January 28th at 11:59 PM. Coaches who do not confirm their lift ticket in advance will be required to purchase tickets at the window.
