Standard Operating Protocols 2009-2010

Program Area: Judges, Technical Delegates

Category: Honorarium

Detail:

The following policy for honorarium applies to Judges and Technical Delegates working at the Canadian Freestyle FIS NorAms, Canadian Freestyle Championships, Canadian Junior National Championships, Canadian Series and any other "national" level event as defined by the CFSA:

1. Judges:

a. Amount:

i. Freestyle FIS NorAms:

1. The amount, number of days and payment of honorarium is indicated in the Freestyle FIS International Competition Rules (ICR).
2. Organizing Committee is responsible for payment of honorarium.

ii. Canadian Freestyle National Championships

1. Judges shall receive \$125.00 CAD for each day of competition.
2. Judges shall receive \$65.00 CAD for each travel day, unless a travel day and competition day are the same. If a travel day and competition day are the same day, then the Judge will receive only \$125.00.
3. Payment shall be made by cheque.
4. The Organizing Committee is responsible for payment to the Judges.
5. T4A tax documents may be issued by the CFSA. This shall be at the discretion of the CFSA.

iii. Canadian Junior National Championships

1. Judges shall receive \$125.00 CAD for each day of competition.
2. Judges shall receive \$65.00 CAD for each travel day, unless a travel day and competition day are the same. If a travel day and competition day are the same day, then the Judge will receive only \$125.00 CAD.
3. Payment shall be made by cheque.
4. The Organizing Committee is responsible for payment to the Judges.

iv. Canadian Series:

1. Judges shall receive \$80.00 CAD for each day of competition.
2. Judges shall receive \$35.00 CAD for each travel day, unless a travel day and competition day are the same. If a travel day and competition day are the same day, then the Judge will receive only \$80.00 CAD.
3. Payment shall be made by cheque.
4. The Organizing Committee is responsible for payment to the Judges.

b. Training Days

i. Freestyle FIS NorAms

1. Training days must be approved by the NorAm Committee and communicated to the Organizing Committee no later than October 31st each year.
2. Judges will be paid only for approved training days.

3. Judges must attend all official training and team captains meetings on the training day to receive the training day honorarium.
 4. Payment of honorarium will be according to the Freestyle FIS ICR.
 - ii. CFSA Sanctioned "National" Level events:
 1. The CFSA Technical Director will approve judges "training days".
 2. Organizing Committees will be informed of official training days no later than October 31st each year.
 3. Judges shall receive \$60 for each approved training day.
 4. Organizing Committee is responsible for payment of honorarium to the Judges.
 - c. Head Judges
 - i. Head Judges shall receive 1 extra day of honorarium for administrative duties prior to and following the competition.
2. Technical Delegates
- a. Amount:
 - i. Freestyle FIS NorAms:
 1. The amount, number of days and payment of honorarium is indicated in the Freestyle FIS International Competition Rules (ICR).
 2. Organizing Committees are responsible for payment of honorarium.
 - ii. Canadian Freestyle National Championships
 1. Technical Delegates shall receive \$125.00 CAD for each day of competition.
 2. Technical Delegates shall receive \$65.00 CAD for each travel day, unless a travel day and competition day are the same. If a travel day and competition day are the same day, then the Technical Delegate will receive only \$125.00.
 3. Payment shall be made by cheque.
 4. The Organizing Committee is responsible for payment to the Technical Delegate.
 5. T4A tax documents may be issued by the CFSA. This shall be at the discretion of the CFSA.
 - iii. Canadian Junior National Championships
 1. Technical Delegates shall receive \$125.00 CAD for each day of competition.
 2. Technical Delegates shall receive \$65.00 CAD for each travel day, unless a travel day and competition day are the same. If a travel day and competition day are the same day, then the Technical Delegate will receive only \$125.00.
 3. Payment shall be made by cheque.
 4. The Organizing Committee is responsible for payment to the Technical Delegate.
 - iv. Canadian Series:
 1. Technical Delegates shall receive \$80.00 CAD for each day of competition.
 2. Technical Delegates shall receive \$35.00 CAD for each travel day, unless a travel day and competition day are the same. If a travel day and competition day are the same day, then the Technical Delegate will receive only \$80.00.
 3. Payment shall be made by cheque.

4. The Organizing Committee is responsible for payment to the Technical Delegate.
3. Other "National Level" Events:
 - a. Honorarium of events not outlined in this policy shall be determined on a case-by-case basis by the CFSA.
